- (1) Number of Homoeopathic Institutions already existing in the State - 45
- (2) Number of seats available or number of Homoeopathic Practitioners being produced annually - 3085
- (3) Number of Homoeopathic Practitioners registered with the State Council of Indian Systems of Medicine - 37742 (approximately)
- (4) Number of Homoeopathic Practitioners in State Government service - Not Available
- (5) Number of vacant Government posts of Homoeopathic doctors in the State particularly in rural/difficult areas - Not Available
- (6) Number of Homoeopathic doctors registered with Employment Exchange - Not Available
- (7) Homoeopathic doctors is to population ratio in the State: - 1:2562
- (8) How the increased intake capacity of College would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State: -
This will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the teaching field. Besides, since the majority of the doctors of this faculty are practising in rural areas, the proposed increased intake capacity will also be beneficial to the rural masses of the state.
- (9) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified:
As per the rules laid down by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time.

(10) Full justification for increase in admission capacity: -

Increase in admission capacity would create more educational opportunities for aspiring students. This will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the teaching field. Besides, since the majority of the doctors of this faculty are practising in the rural area, increased intake capacity will also be beneficial to the rural masses of the state ultimately.

(11) Homoeopathic doctors population ratio is to be achieved - 1:1000

The Principal, Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune had applied to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik to increase in admission capacity of B.H.M.S. course and the said University has recommended to this Government to grant approval to the proposal. The Government of Maharashtra, after conducting inspection of college through the Directorate of Ayurved, Mumbai and considering the report thereof, has decided to issue "No Objection Certificate" to the applicant to increase the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. Course from 75 to 100.

It is certified that -

- a) The applicant owns and manages a 25-bedded Hospital.
- b) It is desirable in the public interest to increase the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. Course from 75 to 100.
- c) Increase the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. Course from 75 to 100 by the Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune is feasible and
- d) It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per the Central Council of Homoeopathy is available with the existing Homoeopathy College.

- (8) How the starting P.G. course would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State :- The number of post graduate seats in the State are less if the Post Graduate seats are increased, the opportunities for getting higher education will increase.
- (9) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified - As per rules of Government of Maharashtra.
- (10) Full justification for starting P.G. courses:- If the Post Graduate seats are increased, the opportunities for getting higher education will increase. This will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel working in the teaching field. Since the majority of the Doctors of this faculty are serving the rural area, the rural masses of the state will also be benefited because of increase in number of Post Graduate qualified doctors.
- (11) Homoeopathic doctors population ratio is be achieved - **1:1000**

The Principal, Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune made application for starting the new P.G. course to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and this University has recommended to this Government to grant approval to the proposal. 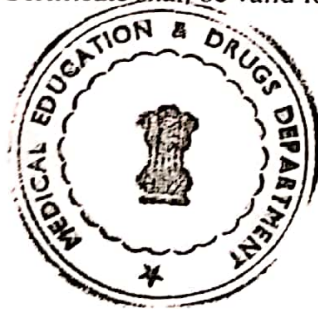
